




# Beach Hot Lunch Survey 2008




**1. Please choose one. Which hot lunch program would you prefer to see offered at Beach next year:**






**2. Please choose one. Our current hot lunches are \$4.00 per single serving lunch and an additional 25 cents for milk, with different costs for different menu items. Revolution Foods hot lunch program charge is \$3.50 per child's meal to BPO. BPO earns approximately \$8,000-\$10,000 from our current hot lunch program. If BPO contracts with Revolution Foods and charges \$4.50 per meal 3 - 5 days per week, BPO will still earn revenues on the hot lunch program. The amount BPO earns from Revolution Foods program depends on how many children participate on each of the hot lunch days (3 or 5 days per week).**
